

# YOUR TAJWEED MADE EASY

A step by step guide to basic Tajweed rules

## LESSON 4 LENGTHEN FOR 1 SECOND (2)

If you see any one of the following 3 signs on a letter then lengthen that sound for 1 second. Standing fatha (karri zabar), standing kasra (karri zer) and upside down dhamma (ulti pesh).

الله - مَالُهُ - إِنَّهُ

يَهُ - نَفْسِهِ - قَوْمِهِ

ذِلْكَ - أَخْرَجَ - سَمْوَاتٍ

عَلَى	نَفْسِتِ	رَأَزْقَنَهُمْ	أَخْرَةٌ	ا Any Letter
قُرْآنٌ	كَتَبَ	أَصْحَبُ	أَدَمَ	Any letter with standing Fatha (karri zabar) on it
أَيْتَهُ	هَذِهِ	الْفِهْمُ	نَفْسِهِ	ا Any Letter
أُمِّهُ	أَهْلِهِ	ظَهْرَهُ	بَيْلِدَهُ	ا Any letter with standing Kasra (karri zer) under it
إِمْرَأَتُهُ	دَأْدَهُ	كِتْبَةٌ	يَرَةٌ	ا Any Letter
نَادِيَةٌ	نَعْمَتَهُ	فِضْلَهُ	حَوْلَهُ	ا Any letter with Upside down Dhamma (ulti pesh) on it

The key thing to remember is lengthen each example above for 1 second.

The sound has to be longer than just a fatha (zabar), kasra (zer) and dhamma (pesh) on a letter.

When you pronounce the following examples there should be a clear difference:

كِتْبَهُ - كِتْبَهُ

هَذِهِ - هَذِهِ

أَخْرَةٌ - أَخْرَةٌ
